Property Rules and Indemnity

Welcome To HeronBridge Retreat Centre! We pray that you will have an enjoyable, inspiring and relaxing stay with us. Please abide by the following simple rules to ensure the smooth running of the property and your safety and enjoyment.

- Do not drink from any taps painted red as these contain river water which is not suitable for drinking.
- **No smoking is allowed in any of our buildings – Designated area is behind Dining Room.**
- We operate a septic tank sewerage system, which is extremely sensitive to any foreign objects. Please use the bins provided for anything other than toilet paper. (Blocked toilets will not make your stay enjoyable!)
- No food or drink allowed in the pool area, which must be kept locked unless adult supervision is present.
- No alcohol is allowed.
- No crockery or cutlery may leave the dining room area.
- The residential cottages and school buildings are strictly out of bounds to campers. Please respect the privacy of our cottage residents.
- Respect other groups and their right to same privileges as you.
- Please keep noise levels down after 22h00 and before 8h00.
- Littering is strictly forbidden and totally unnecessary – please use the bins provided.
- Please lock passage doors which lead to your cubicles so that your possessions are more secure.
- The use of Retreat towels at the pool is not allowed.
- No photographs to be taken of College children.
- On your last day when you leave please **shut windows** but **do not lock individual rooms** – just hand your keys to the camp coordinator who will hand it in at the Retreat Office.
- Chairs may be moved outside for group discussions or whatever but please make sure that all furniture is inside at night.
- No candles allowed in carpeted areas except in case of a power cut.
- Please ensure that your accommodation blocks are locked when you are not in them.
- If your group has valuables please arrange for them to be locked away in cupboards; bring padlocks.
- Children must be supervised at pool.
- Report breakages to the camp hostess or at the Retreat Office as well as any maintenance items needing attention.
